

The airfields detailed represent the busiest civil airports in the UK, based on Civil Air Transport movements, (not overall movements). All of the airfields listed had in excess of 30,000 AT movements during the year 2003. Air Transport flights are primary Airline and Cargo movements. The included airfields will provide the v.h.f. airband listener with the busiest and most interesting frequencies to monitor.

We have included the main company and handling agent frequencies that have been reported at each airfield. It should be noted that the lists may not be complete. In addition to those company frequencies listed, the following primary nationwide airline frequencies should be noted. NB All frequencies in MHz unless specified.

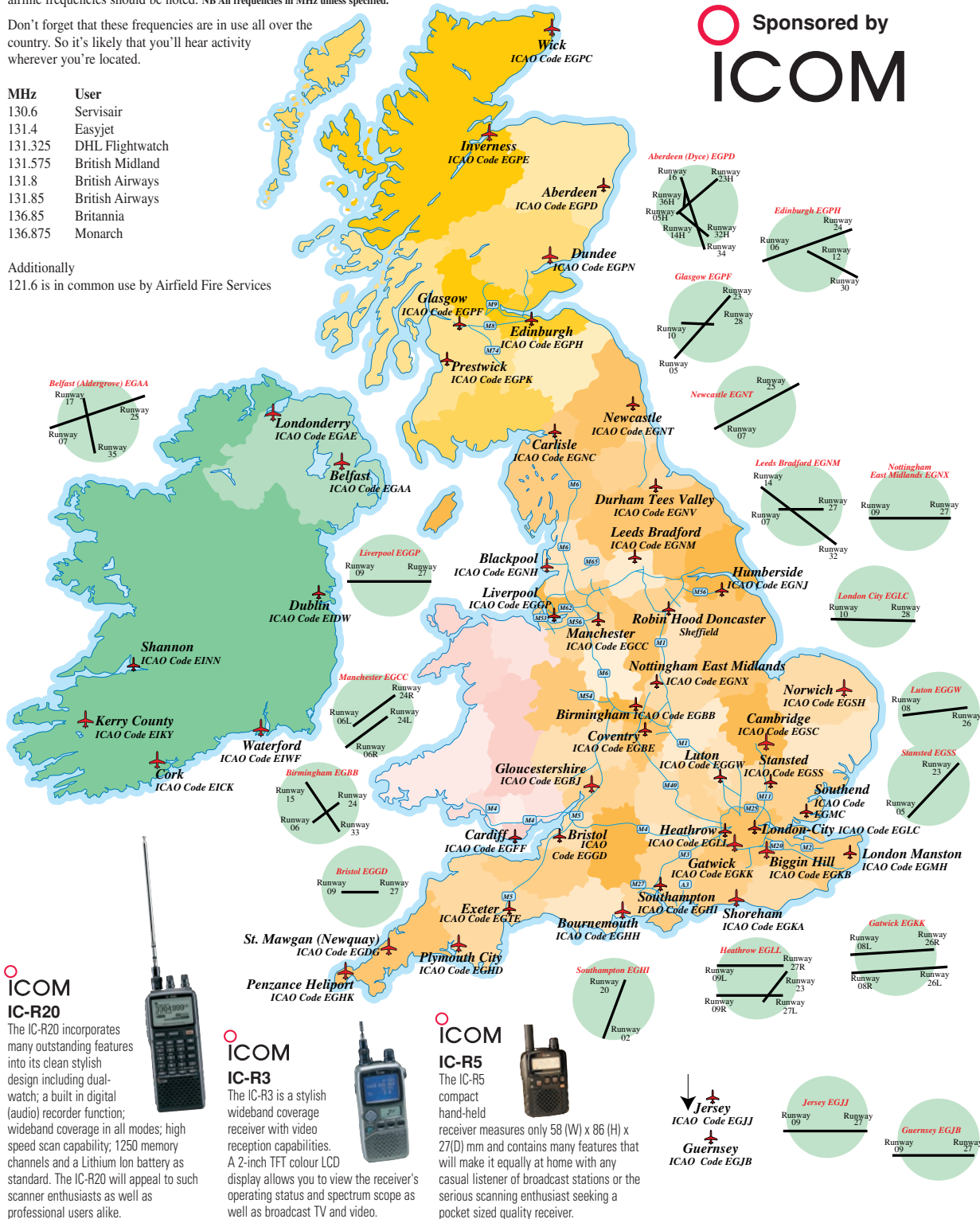
Don't forget that these frequencies are in use all over the country. So it's likely that you'll hear activity wherever you're located.


